

2nd International Women's Tournament Dedicated to International Women's Day

3–8 March 2026 | Weißenhorn, Germany

To celebrate International Women's Day, we are proud to host the 2nd International Women's Tournament in Weißenhorn, following the successful first edition held in Augsburg.



The event brings together female players from around the world in a 9-round Swiss tournament, divided into two groups:

- **Group A** features titled players, including IMs Klaudia Kulon (POL), Laura Unuk (SLO) and Deimantė Daulytė-Cornette (FRA). Participants will have opportunities to achieve **IM and WGM norms**, and the **total prize fund is €6,300**, with **€2,000 for 1st place**.
- **Group B** is designed for **young and developing players (under 1900 ELO)**, though mature players are equally welcome. The **total prize fund is €2,200**. Special prizes will be awarded to senior players (50+) in both groups.
- A unique feature of the event: **players from Group A and Group B can form teams** to compete for **team prizes totaling €1,500**, encouraging collaboration between experienced and younger players.

Both groups are FIDE-rated, and the event takes place at Neumaier's Hirsch Gasthof und Landhotel in Weißenhorn-Attenhofen, alongside the 3rd Viktor Kortschnoi Memorial, a GM norm tournament.

We invite the chess community to support and follow this event. Our goal is to create a special, friendly, and welcoming atmosphere – and to contribute to FIDE's ongoing celebration of women in chess worldwide.
